Board President Worsham,

After communicating with Charles Varvayanis for the last two and a half years about this project, its time frame, etc. We made an assumption that the board of directors was completely informed and would if they required, ask in writing for additional paper work. No letters were received from the board. The only question, "how soon will it be here?" from the board members and residents we spoke to.

Our sub contractors were on site preparing to install Fiber to the Home in your community, for the purpose of providing additional Television programming, Internet and Phone services. "Triple Play Service". We were turned away by your board member Charles, stating that we did not have permission to install the new wire in the park. Quote: "you didn't cross your t's or dot your I's"... Told us to remove our sub contractors equipment from your property. So we have sent our contractors home, not to return in the near future.

At this point in time, I must have made a mistake talking to an individual representing himself as informing the board and not to the board as a whole. For this my apologies. However at this point all of the equipment slated for Sierra Park is now redirected to other areas with no plans to proceed into your community. Our contractors have been paid for their time. I see our cost escalating to high in Sierra Park to proceed further at this moment.

Your community was to be the first community in Tuolumne County to have Fiber to the Home. Sorry, but the title and benefits will now be elsewhere.



Re: Transfer of ownership of Meyerhoff Cable

Meyerhoff Cable has been purchased by Sierra Nevada Communications (SNC). SNC plans to continue to provide, improve and replace the current infrastructure over time. If requested we will provide proof of insurance. SNC will assume unless otherwise provided in writing that Sierra Park Association will continue to grant permission for SNC to continue to use existing right-of-ways established in the Meyerhoff letter of acceptance May 10, 1982.

SNC has secured from Tuolumne County the commitment to transfer the Tuolumne County Franchise Agreement. We have also secured right-a-ways clearance from SBC, PGE and Tuolumne County right-of-ways and are currently working on State and Federal right-of-ways.

The TV system will be built on the utility poles where it is practical and underground where it is not feasible to go on existing poles. We plan to begin with the system design and layout as soon as we get your permission.
