

EQUIPMENT

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Shop # 1 next to fuel tanks and fire truck.

Most of the equipment and tools in this shop belongs to Mike the caretaker. However, the following belongs to the park.

1. New standing air compressor.
2. Old air compressor. (Mike wants to repair this unit and place it in the other shop) (where the snow plow is.)
3. Floor jack.
4. Gas welder.
5. New echo power pack blower.
6. Creeper.
7. Three chain saws two - twelve inch, one thirty inch.
8. Three weed eaters of various sizes and conditions.
9. One reaching chain saw for cutting branches.

Mike's stuff @ shop #1

Metal lathe, drill press, parts washer, table grinder, self standing grinder, table saw, metal band saw, table vise, large standing vise, table cutter, special sharpening device, large press, skill saws, 225 amp arch welder, hand greaser, air greaser, an assortment of nuts and bolts, various tables and desks.

#9 Fire engine 500 gal tank

Water pump leaks and only works at about 40% capacity. Both the main engine and the pump engine have weak batteries. The water hoses need to be replaced. (about 200 ft). If the water pump were replaced or repaired the fire engine could store water (without leaks) and have better firefighting readiness with 100% water pressure. As it is, it takes about an hour to get the tank filled and the pump primed and ready. If these repairs were made this unit could make a big difference in a fire situation. Also, so far as I know, Mike the caretaker is the in only person who knows how to run this rig. If a fire started and Mike wasn't here can we depend on the fire department getting here quickly enough?

This unit is in excellent condition. Odometer reading is 13500 mi. Mike needs two new bags of snow chains for this coming winter.

#7 Bush hog mower

This unit works OK. Mike does PM (preventative Maintenance) and patches it up as needed. It is used to keep the grass down around the recreational areas. Used about 20 hours a year.

Grader

The grader is used as a back up snowplow when the regular plow is down or in an exceptionally bad snow year it might be used if there were an operator. This unit is "gaining oil" meaning fuel is leaking into the oil pan causing the oil to thin. This loss of oil viscosity could cause damage to the engine if the oil were not changed often while in use. The most likely and cheapest way to cure this problem is to replace the crossover fuel lines. Mike is aware of this problem and changes the oil as needed. The grader does not get used every year.

New 2005 Toyota Tacoma, Short bed Pick up

Maybe washable seat covers would be a good idea.

Old (six wheel) park truck

This truck is only used in the park now. It is still in fair condition (needs tune up). It is four wheel drive and has studded tires. There has been talk about putting a flat bed on this unit for hauling welders and big dirty stuff which might help prolong the life of the new truck or at least help keep it looking new. Also a snow blade on the front of this truck could be handy behind the snow plow for clean up.

This unit is in good shape for park use.

#45 Back hoe w/12 and 18 inch buckets

This unit is in very good condition. Needs two new front tires before this coming winter.

Wood chipper

This unit is in very good condition.

Needs battery

-12 foot trailer

Never used- possible welding trailer
