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	What is the Odd Fellow Sierra Park? The Odd Fellow Sierra Park is about 600 acres beautifully timbered land with a large meadow and year around creek running through it
Question	with a 100 acres subdivision about the meadow. Where is the Park located?
-	The Park is 17 miles east of Sonora and 2 miles west of Long Barn on Highway 108, elevation 4500 feet. A sign on the highway marks the entrance to the Park.
Question	Who owns the Park?
Answer	The Odd Fellow Sierra Recreation Association, a non profit corpora- tion, owns the park. This Association is made up of Odd Fellows and Rebekahs who own an interest in the Association.
Question	Who manages the Park?
Answer	An elected board of nine directors serving 3 year terms operating un- der the by laws of the Association with officers President, Vice-Presi- dent and SecTreas. elected from the board each year.
Question	Who may become a member of the Association?
Answer	A member in good standing of any subordinate or Rebekah lodge by the purchase of one building site and will be entitled to one vote in the Association.
Question	Is the Park a resort or commercial enterprise?
Answer	No. It is for Odd Fellows and Rebekahs interested in mountain recrea- tion.

Question What developments are there?

Answer Electric power by the P.G. & E. available to each lot. Telephone service available to each lot. Access roads to each lot. Hard surface road from highway to the meadow. Water available to each lot; water is owned and controlled by the members of the Association.

Question What about the recreation?

Answer The Park is in the heart of good fishing and hunting territory. A camping and picnic area is available to all members of the order and their families.

Hard surface area for volley ball, badminton, dancing, etc. There is a two acre lake in the meadow for swimming.

A few miles east of the Park is the fine Dodge Ridge ski resort.

A large Recreation Hall built by the members is available for social and fraternal use.

- Question How can you own a lot and have a cabin in the Odd Fellows Sierra Park?
- Answer \$750 will purchase a lot of your choice either by easy time payments or for cash. Yearly expenses—association fees \$12 per year, water \$12 per year. Taxes paid to county.
