The report on the road work as submitted by Harold Clement was read stating that he had placed 1,428 yards of rock on the roads.

After some discussion, the Secty. was instructed to write to Mr. Bauman and offer the tank to him for \$150.00 as is, where is. The matter of delinquent accounts was discussed and the Secty. was instructed to turn these accounts over to the attorney for collection.
