The President appointed Bernice Allred chairman of landscaping committee.

Motion by Hodgson seconded by Hosmer that we pay mileage to Directors for 3rd quarter 1952.

Motion by Hodgson seconded by Spangle that we have our lumber stored at the Park refiled and covered to protect it from the weather.

No further business appearing, the meeting was adjourned.
