Meeting called to order by Jay Gibson president at 8.15. P.M. at the home of Tony Escobar in Manteca. The roll of directors called and absentees noted. Those present were Gibson, Nichols, Hosmer, Escobar, Kearns, Buck & Rhien Biachi arrived later, Absent Hodgson.

The minutes of October 1 st, were read and approved as read. Communications; A letter from Geo Ackyey our Attorney, enclosing a statement from Oakland Lodge, showing that we still owe them \$ 2324.00

Our president showed us some Mimeograph sheets that he had made up, to be sent to persons, writing in for information on our park, and would meet the requirements, until such time that it could be made into booklet form, after some corrections it was accepted.

Committe reports; The committe on the spring near the girl scout camp, reported that the project was nearly completed, and that the elec electric service was in, and with a little more work the project would be ready to go.

After some comments on the ad in the Odd Fellows And Rebekah paper It was moved seconded and carried that the secretary write to Bob Smith, thanking him for the manner in which the ads and other write ups were presented.

The Finance Committe reported on the loan, as voted by the Membership, at a special meeting September 1st. 1957 stating that we could get a loan from Charity Lodge At 6% interest. The committe was to confer with Charity Loge and make arraingements for the loan. Gene Bianchi stated that Arnold Nelson spoke to him about the timber in the park stating that there was no sale for timber at the present time and that he would rather wait until spring. The secretary was instructed to write to Mr. Nelson informing him of the board's action that it would be O.K. to take the timber out in the spring,

Gene also reported that Walter Hardgrove had spoken to him regarding the maps fore subdividing the old Lodge Site, stating that he thought that the county would require conture information on the maps, and if so, there would have to be some surveying done first,

Bianchi was instructed to inform Hardgrove to make the maps and send them to the secretary to be sent to the Board of Supervisors in Sonora.

Bianchi Stated that he was going to have a distinguished visitor and among other things, would discuss the Odd Fellows And Rebekahs boys camp, and would like to have a letter from the Board through the secretary on the action taken on the donation of a piece of property to the youth movement. It was moved seconded and carried that the secretary write a letter to Gene Bianchi Appraising him of the board's action and that he also send him a Photostatic copy of the letter received from our Deputy Grand Master Don Smith in answer to our donation.
