

ODD FELLOWS SIERRA RECREATION ASSOCIATION

June 30 1956

Meeting called to order by Gene Bianchi president at 8 P.M. at his cabin at the park. Those present were Bianchi, Hodgson, Nichols, Boydston, Buck, Hosmer and Rhien. Absent Escobar and Gibson. The minutes of June 17 were read and approved as read. The president brought up the matter of the road contract in the amount of 5377.00 with Bierman and Jones. Extra labor and material of approximately 25 feet for turnouts and into side roads at 11cents a foot. It was suggested by Bob Hodgson that stakes be set up to limit road extension and turn outs.

The president stated that he had a talk with Arthur Bauman regarding the timber cut on the P.G.&E. right of way and that his wife would not sign the papers sent to them by our attorney and that he wanted one half the proceeds of the timber sale and be credited with same. The president also stated that Bauman had about \$2500.00 worth of timber and that he would give the association one half of that and that he had subdivided some of the land into lots and would give the association all the money brought in on the sale of the lots.

After some discussion it was moved seconded and carried that we give Bauman credit for one half the P.G. & E timber sale.

It was moved seconded and carried that we accept one half of the money of the timber cut by Bauman and that we insist that the Rangers scale the timber cut. It was moved seconded and carried that we accept the full purchase price of the lots until the full purchase price of the property is paid. Modesto Lumber Co Galvanized Iron Roofing for tank roof 99.32. Oakdale Concrete Pipe Yard Pipe for culverts \$52.43 P.G.&E. Electric Service for pump #2 16.23 Electric Service from Nov. to May Water system #1 126.83 Ray Reans helping Garrett install Culverts 12.00 R.C. Rhien Telephone Calls \$ 3.41 Stamped Envelopes \$7.37 Department of Employment \$30.50 Director of Internal Revenue \$107.10 Total \$ 804. 89.

The following bills were orderd paid A.L. Escobar for supplies for the pot-luck 10.32 After some discussion on the dump truck it was moved seconded and carried that Nichols and Boydston Get a mechanic to put the truck in running order. The president stated that Mrs. Leonard Taylor talked to him about the two lots that they purchased and that they only wanted one lot and after some discussion it was moved seconded and carried that Taylor be charged for only one lot and that the former motion on the subject at the meeting of Dec 11 1955 be deleted. The secretary was instructed to write to Bro. Taylor appraising him of the Board action. After some discussion on the way some of the work was handled at the park it was moved seconded and carried that Nichols and Boydston be appointed to to oversee the work at the park under the boards direction and use their own good judgment in making decision.
