UNFINISHED BUS: A discussion was held on the matter of the well and it was decided that various well drillers would be contacted by Wm. Greeno to see about drilling. Kelley was instructed to purchase the posts. Kelley was also instructed to place a cable across the road in the campground.

NEW BUSINESS: Bro. Rhein outlined water pressures that he and Bob Nichols had taken on the various lines in the Park and suggested that pressure reducing valves be placed at necessary points. It was moved and carried that this be done. Loren Hosmer was appointed to work with Kelley in the placing of these reducing valves. A discussion was held regarding the bridge across the creek on Jordan Way. Herman Wood was appointed to investigate the possibility of temporary repairs for this winter.
