GARBAGE_INNOVATIONS - Cal Sierra Garbage Company has informed us that due to county imposed restrictions, we must separate our garbage more effectively or be charged triple for it. There must be only household garbage in the dumpster or it will be hauled back, required to be separated, then hauled out again, thus imposing three hauling fees of \$281 each for the one load - and we still have to have someone separate all that stuff out. HOMEOWNERS MUST NOTIFY THEIR RENTERS OF THIS NEW REQUIREMENT. There will be more complete information on this next month.

HOLIDAY DINNERS - As listed in the minutes we will have our annual Thanksgiving dinner on November 9,1991 and our annual Christmas Dinner on December 14,1991. These are Saturday nights so that as many members as possible can attend and enjoy the fellowship. In both dinners the Board will supply the meat, so that members will bring all the other fixings that go along with it. COMMITTEE REPORTS

WATER - Smith-Pernetti - Water use: 1,800,000 gals. Well #1 was tested. Wells #2,3,4 are officially inactive. We are in the process of repairing one of our water tanks. This is a temporary repair and we suspect this tank will need to be replaced within the next few years. We were inspected by the state and received a very favorable review.

ROADS - Mitchell - Anyone planning to asphalt their driveway needs to see Dale Smith before you begin the work. Your driveway must be compatible with the snowplow. We are cleaning bar ditches. We are requesting homeowners to clean their culverts. If you are planning to install a culvert see Dale Smith for instructions. The Board wants to thank the volunteers who helped with the road work this summer. Gates and "NOT A THROUGH ROAD" signs are being installed at some of the back country access roads.

BUILDINGS - Mitchell - None

TIMBER - Adams - Sold 99,000 BD. FT. of timber. We received a profit of \$7,986.00.

RECREATION - Greene - Thanksgiving potluck dinner will be November 9 at 6:30 PM. Christmas Potluck Dinner will be December 14 at 6:30 PM. This is a good opportunity to meet new people, get new recipes and for kids to meet new playmates.

EQUIPMENT - Harvey - The new snowplow is in Lodi and being fitted with dump bed and plow. The old dump truck was sold for \$3,200.00. MSC to add a transmission cooler to the new snowplow truck.

FINANCE - Zobel - Bills for Homeowners Association: \$326.03. Bills for Recreation Association: \$10,648.58. Bills for Timber checking \$0.00. MSC to pay the bills. October income: \$11,576.04. MSC to get a second opinion on the taxability of income to pay for the snowplow.

OLD BUSINESS - There was an insurance discussion on the new truck. The Board would like to thank Roy Starr for his help in determining the course of action on the water tank.
