SPECIAL NOTE FOR WINTERIZING

Fall is here and with it comes wind , rain, and maybe snow. This time of year brings the possibility of tree limbs and branches getting caught on your power and phone wires. If you can remove them safely, do so. Otherwise call the utility company and have them remove the branches.

Check your water box cover; make sure it has a secure cover so snow and debris won't cause a problem with freezing or access to your water valves.

Winterize your cabins!!

Some members believe that leaving a faucet running will keep the system from freezing. Two problems with this are: it wastes water and it doesn't always work. A good way to protect your supply pipes and drains is to treat the traps, toilet bowl and tank with some form of anti-freeze, and drain all supply lines and the hot water heater.

CARETAKERS REPORT - Water meter was repaired thanks to Jim Clifton.

MEMBERS BEFORE THE BOARD - 1. Jeff & Sandra Reed - Questioning ownership of family lot.

COMMITTEE REPORTS -WATER -Smith--Water use: 405,000 gals. MSC to purchase an additional water tank from Central Valley Tank Co.

ROADS -Morrison - Culverts need to be cleaned due to heavy rains. It would be appreciated if owners would clean their own site.

BUILDINGS - Smith - There was some damage to the Recreation Hall due to the heavy rain recently. The builder's insurance will handle the damages. The roof on the Recreation Hall is in the process of being replaced.

TIMBER -Adams - There was some discussion of fire prevention & protection. We will look for more information when Adams is in attendance. The Board wishes to caution homeowners to observe dead growth in trees above their homes or cabins.

RECREATION - Hawke - November 12 will be annual Thanksgiving Pot-luck with turkey furnished by the Board of Directors and other dishes to go with it furnished by members. Bring your favorite dish: salad, vegetable, dessert, etc. As in the past, the Odd fellows will hold their meeting at 6 PM with the dinner to begin at 6:30 PM.

HEALTH AND SAFETY - Morgenroth - See the special instructions for winterizing cabins. Lets try to avoid frozen pipes - it is time to consider that.

EQUIPMENT -Rairden - The new sander is installed and will be operational in 10 days. Dale is getting the tractor cab ready for winter.

FINANCE-Zobel- MSC to purchase additional general liability insurance to bring us up to what is required. Bills for the Recreation Association: \$ 15,599.12. MSC to pay the bills. Balance for Recreation Association checking \$ 72,637.84.

OLD BUSINESS - None

NEW BUSINESS - Renter on David (lot 22 block 23) parks by fire hydrant. Letter to be sent to him to remove his vehicle or he may be fined and towed at his expense. A letter is to be sent to the owner of lot 11, block 9 that his fifth wheel is to be removed from the area.
