OLD BUSINESS - The Board wishes to thank all concerned with the memorial work by the flag pole - especially Glen Mitchell. All delinquent accounts have been turned over to a collection agency. One account has since been paid.

NEW BUSINESS -M/S/C to buy a live Christmas tree to be planted in front of the lodge at a cost of up to \$150.00.

By using the dump truck for off road only we are saving on liability insurance. Jim Morrison donated a microwave oven to the Park.

There being no further business, the meeting was adjourned at 9:55 AM. The next regular meeting will be held Jan.10, 1993 at 9:00 AM.
