COMMUNICATIONS RECEIVED: Hector and Karyn Levya - stating they had yet to receive the deed to their property that was bought last year. The County has again been notified to send them a deed, and Wallis will communicate with the Leyva's to be sure the County follows through. The Board apologizes to the Leyva's for their inconvenience. Albert J. Granucci - Informing the Board of damage to their 1978 Deluxe Camper caused during snow removal efforts. The camper was parked on their property. The claim was been turned over to the Park's insurance company. Douglas M. Sutter, Attorney for Irving J. Elliott - Acknowledging our negotiated settlement. See Real Estate Committee report. MEMBERS BEFORE THE BOARD Warren B. Tracy - Delivered to the Secretary two amendments to be voted on at the coming general meeting. One pertaining to the sale of property and the second concerning tree removal. See attachment for their full text. CARETAKER'S REPORT - Snow removal efforts continued, worked on sanding roads and removing brush off of streets. ROADS - Johnson: Extensive patching is going to be required this year. A program/ project is being developed. WATER - Bell: Water distribution maps are progressing. EQUIPMENT - Gibson: General maintenance being performed. RECREATION (Social) - Harmer: Potluck dates have been changed. They will be held the second Monday of every month at 6:30 P.M. Reported that District Eleven Odd Fellows and Rebekahs requested to rent the barbecue area for July 15, 1979. The appropriate deposit was forwarded. Motion by Gibson, sec. by Wallis to approve request. Passed 7-0. Recreation Committee met on April 7, 1979, and their recommendations follow. REAL ESTATE - Wallis: Negotiations for property on Lot 25, Block 23 have been settled. The Park returned \$664.58. This action settles a claim since 1974 caused by a resale of property. HEALTH AND SAFETY - Akers: Motion by Wallis, sec. by Gibson to apply for a burning permit for a central point within the Park till June 1, 1979, or until the U.S. Forestry controls stop the burning. The dumping will be from 10:00 A.M. to 4:00 P.M. The purpose for this permit is for natural vegetation only, and dumping will only be tolerated on the weekends. Passed 7-0. Motion by Gibson, sec. by Wallis to apply a cement apron on the inside of the lake around drain pipes to prevent leakage. Passed 7-0. FINANCE - Stephenson: Motion by Stephenson, sec. by Wallis to fay Bully.
