COMMUNICATIONS RECEIVED:

U.S. Dept. of Agriculture - Requesting permission / access to unload tractor on our dirt road for tree planting site preparation in August and September. Two trips are required. Motion by Wallis, sec. by Gibson to approve request. Passed 6-0. Cal Sierra Disposal Inc. - Submitted garbage service bid for 1979-80. See new business.

MEMBERS BEFORE THE BOARD:

Joe Nelson - Park member and U.S. Gov't authority on dams reported to the Board on his views of the lake seepage problem and recommended a way to solve the seepage. The Board appreciates his advice and has begun work.

CARETAKER'S REPORT:

Took one week vacation (Compensating time off), installed water service on David and Jordan Way, repaired water lines at pump and performed equip. maintenance.

ROADS: Johnson - Gave a report on work required for 1979-80. Shoulder work, overlays, patching, etc. were included in the report. A full report and recommendation will be discussed at the annual meeting.

WATER: Bell - The preliminary water distribution maps were reviewed. Proposed work for 1979-80 was discussed. A complete report and recommendation will be proposed at the annual meeting. There will be an American Water Works Assoc. meeting in San Francisco during June. Motion by Wallis, sec. by Stephenson to pay Bell's registration fees and mileage expenses.

EQUIPMENT: Gibson - General maintenance was performed. There was a motion to approve the purchase of a second hand Int'l 1968 four wheel drive with 21,000 miles - cost \$3,800.00. Passed 5-0 (Stephenson - yes, Gibson - yes, Wallis - abstain, Akers - yes, Johnson - yes)

RECREATION (SOCIAL): Harmer - Twain Harte Twilers requested renting the recreation hall for June 23. The appropriate deposit was forwarded. Motion by Stephenson, sec. by Akers to approve the application. Passed 6-0.

HEALTH AND SAFETY: Akers - Discussed burning of pine needles until June 1. The caretaker's cabin needs to have the fireplace repaired for safety reasons. Motion by Wallis, sec. by Akers to authorize the expenditure of \$750.00 for the personal repairs. Passed 6-0.

FINANCE: Stephenson - Motion by Stephenson, sec. by Wallis to pay the bills. Passed 6-0.
