SIERRA PARK LODGE #376 Odd Fellows meetings are held the 2nd & 4th Sat. of each month at 7 PM in the Rec. PINE NEEDLES As noted last month the burn area is closed for the summer by order of the Forestry Department. Burnables can be taken to Fiberboard Mill at Standard.

ANNUAL STEAK BARBECUE - Annual Labor Day Barbecue will be held September 1, 1991. Plans are underway for that event (see minutes). Prices will be \$5.00 for adults and \$2.00 for children under 12. All members and friends are invited. Bring games of your choice to play.

From time to time it has been necessary to allow a delivery truck to bring materials to the barbecue area, but this is to be on a limited basis only. All members and guests should observe this rule.

CARETAKERS REPORT - Repairing and oiling roads. Got estimate for road building material for new garbage road.

CORRESPONDENCE - Letters from: 1. State of California stating Bay-Delta Water plan is completed. 2. Sonora Insurance re; Auto policy endorsement. 3. Ruth Peoples questioning equipment assessment. 4. Phillip Butler re: requesting his address be given to bookkeeper for billing. 5. California State Health Services stating that monitoring data must be submitted on proper form. 6. Doris Wallers complaining of trash in neighboring lot. 7. Ingrid Brown complaining of loose dogs in the Park, and asking for help because she is afraid. 8. OFSRA to County of Tuolumne re: septic system on property of John & Nancy Bordes. 9. Attorney Dambacher to surveyors for report on Gellatly retaining wall. 9A. Response from surveyor stating wall is on park property.

MEMBERS BEFORE THE BOARD - 1. Mrs. Bettencourt (25358 Esther) complaining of possible encroachment and fire safety violations in neighboring lot. 2. Mr. & Mrs. Matt Adamowicz complaining of mess left by tree harvester behind their property. Also large dead trees on park property behind his property: Referred to Dale for inspection. 3. Bob Hintz requesting placing of disposition of problems in the minutes. 4. Stan Robinson with information on off-road vehicle policy and possible A.T.V. School in the Park.

COMMITTEE REPORTS - WATER - Smith-Pernetti - Water use: 2,400,000 gals. ROADS - Mitchell - Maintenance is being done such as sealing and oiling.

BUILDINGS - Mitchell - The well house is 80% completed. The Caretaker's cabin has a new roof.

TIMBER - Adams - Contact the caretaker for information on where to cut firewood for personal use.

HEALTH AND SAFETY - Clifton - KEEP PINE NEEDLES OUT OF THE GARBAGE. Our burn area is closed by order of the State Fire Service. Slash can be taken to Fiberboard Mill in Standard. Signs are being repainted.

EQUIPMENT - Harvey - We could not find any suitable used snow plows after extensive investigation. Bids for a new snow plow will be examined at the August 11 meeting and a contract awarded.

RECREATION - Clifton - The fish derby was a success. Thanks to all who helped.

FINANCE - Zobel - Bills for Homeowners Association: \$58,437.50. Bills for Recreation Association: \$14,416.89. Bills for Timber checking \$0.00. MSC to pay the bills. Income: \$50,920.24.

OLD BUSINESS - MSC to construct additional parking on Jordan Way East. The Forest Service may have designated trails for off-road vehicles in the future. Tuolumne County notified us that there are no county owned roads in our park. We will gate entrances and the County will affix signs to that effect.

Labor Day Barbecue is set for September 1, 1991 from 4 PM to 6 PM. Prices will be \$5.00 for steak dinner and \$2.00 for children's hot dogs.

NEW BUSINESS - John Lackey - Sonora Insurance Agency - reviewed our insurance package. MSC to pave a road, build a gate and build a turn-around spot in the new garbage area.

It was noted that in Pinecrest the annual fee is \$2100.00.

Richard Bonner requested the use of the picnic grounds for July 27.

Bill Kilgore requested the use of the picnic grounds for August 10.

Wayne Harvey requested the use of the picnic grounds for Sept. 14.

There being no further business, the meeting was adjourned at 12:15 PM.
