Board of Directors Meeting Minutes September 16, 2006

The Board of Directors meeting was called to order at 8:30 A.M. by President Charles Varvayanis. The invocation was offered by Clark Kellogg. Those present were President Charles Varvayanis, Secretary Mike Rainwater, Treasurer Doris Selman, Members Mike Ford, and Clark Kellogg. Absent were Alan Orth and Dan Meade, excused and Vice President Mike Van Gundy and Steve Wallace, unexcused.

Members before the board: None.

Minutes: The minutes of the August meeting were approved as mailed. (Motion Varvayanis/Selman, Unanimous)

Correspondence: 1) Letters/Flyers concerning Water Programs, U.S. Water News, Letter from Dept. of Health Services regarding a past testing, Ad. From ACE Hardware, and letter from A&A Portables.

Committee Reports

Water – Rainwater: Water usage was 1,123,600 gals. Water leak on owners property at 25322 Esther. Monthly report from Aqua Lab indicates the Park's water is very good. Copper and lead report from Aqua Lab indicates that the Park passed with no problems.

Roads – Wallace: Mr. Kellogg mentioned that the oiling by Reed was good in most areas, however; there were some areas that were only adequate.

Buildings – Kellogg: Receiving quotes on a new heater for the lodge.

Timber – Ford: Presented a letter from ACRT that he had signed giving permission to drop the dead trees in the park for PGE.

Recreation – Meade: It was reported that Bingo night was very successful and we made approx. \$450.00 for the Park's fishing derby.

Health & Safety – Varvayanis: Nothing new, however Mr. Kellogg requested that our caretaker rebuild the metal steps at the garbage bin. They need a toe plate in order that an individual does not slip through the steps.

Equipment – Orth: The Park truck has now been equipped with a rack and two side boxes for tools.

Finance – Selman: Motion to pay the bills as presented, reviewed, and signed. (Kellogg/Varvayanis, Unanimous). The cost of paving the roads \$26,900 will be paid out of capital expenses and will be reimbursed from a timber CD that matures on 9/29/2006.

Old Business: 1) An unofficial heading at the site of Park's unofficial Web site lists it as unofficial. 2) Approved the purchase of the materials for completion of the Esther water line, motion (Selman/Varvayanis, Passed, 1 Abstained)

New Business: 1) Board has received multiple complaints regarding the former Boy Scout property and the new owners. The Coleman's sent a letter to the Board concerning their interests in the problems with the above mentioned property. The Board discussed the matter in length and decided to meet with the owners and discuss the situation. 2) Regarding the policy of wood cutting in the Park was tabled. 3) Varvayanis stated that past newsletters are available on the web only. Return postal mail will not be resent. If returned, newsletter will be suspended until you notify us of changes.

Other Business: None

Next meeting is on October 21st at 8:30 a.m.

Being no further business, the meeting adjourned at 12:20 P.M.
