Hello,

We have recently been notified by PG&E that they will be trimming and removing more trees. The new standards PG&E are using require vegetation be removed within 12 feet of power conductors including 12 feet above them. If a tree cannot be trimmed to achieve these clearances and still be considered to be a "healthy" tree, they will remove the entire tree.

PG&E has gone through the Park and marked trees. Trees with yellow dots will be trimmed and trees with a yellow X will be removed. If a tree is being removed, PG&E has also placed a hanger on the door of the cabin on that property.

If property owners do not request log removal BEFORE trees are cut PG&E will not remove the logs and it will be the owners responsibility to remove them. Sierra Park's old campground area will not be open to accepting logs that have been left behind as we just do not have the space for them.

We realize that it is not easy for everyone to come and check their property to see if their trees are affected. If you are not coming up to your property within the next week, contact a neighbor to see if you have a PG&E door hanger with the information to contact them; or you can contact PG&E at 1-800-743-5000 for information.
