President's Message

This has been a busy month for the Water Company! The drought and new regulations associated with it will be having an effect on our operations. Details at the annual meeting, but here are some topics that will be discussed:

Water usage - the State's mandated 20% reduction applies to the Park, too, and we must report our usage monthly. In past years our spring water usage has run 800,000 gallons or more per month. We now need to keep that number closer to 600,000 gallons - so far March and April have met this goal. Please continue to conserve and report any water problems to our call center number, 209-533-7998.

All homes are now required to have vacuum breakers at each outdoor hose bibb (faucet). We will be providing two per household at the meeting, along with instructions. Assistance with installation will be available if needed.

The Capital Improvement Plan work is underway, with the first phase expected to wrap up by the end of this month. Future phases will affect other areas of the Park; homeowners will be advised in advance if work will disrupt their water supply. Thanks to all for their cooperation during this upgrade.

We are working with the Water Resources Board to determine the solution to our water's manganese level. Latest information will be provided at the meeting, along with a discussion of options to be explored.

In case of a break or interruption of service, notify the call center right away so our team can investigate the cause. Do not call the Water Resources Board directly. Anyone filing a false report of an incident will be reported to the Tuolumne County Sheriff's office. Please follow the established procedure.

The meeting was called to order at 8:30 by President Kirk Knudsen.

BOARD MEMBERS PRESENT: Michael Lechner, Bill Ordwein, Heidi Ordwein, Wanda Lenhardt and Kirk Knudsen participated via tel con.

SHAREHOLDERS PRESENT: Mark Logan joined the meeting after it had begun.

OTHERS PRESENT: Sue Collie joined the meeting after it had commenced.

Comments from Attendees: Sue Collie had questions regarding her stock, internet access and the gate.

MINUTES OF BOARD MEETING: Review/Approval of the April 11, 2015 Board meeting minutes was put on hold pending the final review of the minutes by all board members.

CORRESPONDENCE

Phone: A water leak was reported. It was not a leak in the water system but a leach line issue.

DIRECTOR REPORTS:

President - Kirk Knudsen - No new news to report.

Vice President - Michael Lechner - Nothing to report.

Secretary - Wanda Lenhardt - The April newsletters were delayed due to a technical problem in the transfer of the document. Efforts will be made to resolve the issue.

Treasurer - Bill Ordwein reported that the accountants were not able to prepare a report in final form due to the meeting occurring early in the month. Information will be provided at the next board meeting. Bill continues to work on preparing a report for the annual meeting. The financial statement will be provided in the May Newsletter.

Human Resources - Heidi Ordwein - Nothing to report.

Director of Capital Improvement - Bill Ordwein - The water liprovement project is scheduled to begin next week. The west side of the Park will be shut off as part of that project. Boil water notices given and the water will be tested once it is turned back on. The notices will remain in effect as a precaution until water test results show the water is safe to drink. Efforts have been made to explore ways of monitoring the water levels in the storage tanks. A pressure valve has been located that will create automatic readings. There is no new news on the manganese pilot.

OLD BUSINESS:

Next newsletter is slated for the week of May 18, 2015. Efforts will be made to diagnose the problem with last newsletter.

NEW BUSINESS:

- Budget review The balances in the accounts will be reduced significantly next month due to expenditures which are anticipated during this next month.
- Mountaineering Engineering Pilot study proposal (Manganese) will begin soon in accordance with the motion passed earlier in the meeting.
- Capital Improvement schedule previously discussed during the Director's Reports.
- Preparation for 2015 Annual Stockholders meeting and election.

Closure - The meeting moved to executive session at 10:10. Mark Logan was invited to attend the executive session as a consultant. Executive Session ended 10:27. There was nothing to report.

The April minutes were reviewed. Heidi Ordwein made the motion to accept the minutes. Bill Ordwein seconded the motion that was then unanimously passed.

Next meeting is scheduled for June 6th at 8:30 am.
