Public hearing was opened to consider removal of a portion of Long Barn-Sugarpine Road from the County-maintained road system at the request of the Odd Fellows Sierra Park Recreation Association.

Alan Roberts, Acting Director, Transportation and Engineering Services, presented the staff report.

Speaking in favor of the abandonment were Gordon Graham, Odd Fellows Park Recreation Association and Alvin Kidder, Cedarbrook Boy Scout Camp.

Opposing the abandonment was John Wylie who lives within the confines of the park.

Mr. Graham spoke in rebuttal and Mr. Wylie in surrebuttal.
