RE: Road Maintenance

Significant damage to the park's paved road occurred this last winter and spring. The damage was caused by inadequate drainage, clogged or inadequate bar ditches, no driveway culverts, culverts of insufficient size and culverts not set at the proper depth.

Repairing the road surface (laying new asphalt) without correcting the drainage problem is a waste of money.

The letter is to inform you of our plan for road maintenance:

1. A list of all lot and block numbers where a drainage deficiency exists has been made,
2. All property owners on this list must:
 - a. Install a culvert of adequate size if no culvert exists,
 - b. If a culvert exists but is not set at the proper depth, it must be re-set to the proper depth,
 - c. If the ends of the culvert are crushed or blocked, it must be opened up and cleaned out.

The property owner at his or her discretion may do their own work or the Home Owners Association will do the work for fixed price. In all cases, the work must be completed within 30 days of receipt of this letter.

The Recreation Association will install a 12" diameter 20' long galvanized steel culvert for a fixed fee of \$175.00. The \$175.00 to be paid within 30 days of job completion.

If the home owner asks the Sierra Recreation Association to re-set the culvert we will:

1. Excavate the culvert and inspect it,
2. If the culvert is of adequate size, adequate length and is structurally sound the Recreation Association will re-set the culvert at *no cost* to the home owner,

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3. If the culvert is not adequate or structurally sound, the Recreation Association will install a new culvert (12" Diameter 20' long, galvanized steel) for a fixed fee of \$175.00 due and payable in 30 days.

This will be done as a one time operation as it is not cost effective to rent the equipment and have to come back.
