OFFICIAL NOTICE TO ALL PROPERTY OWNERS

FROM THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS

At the annual meeting of the Odd Fellows Sierra Recreation Association on May 24, 1987, it was brought to the attention of the board that the use of motor bikes, two, three and four wheelers, skate boards and scooters are not abiding by the rules of the park, and that dogs were still running loose and in the lake area.

We must first remind you that in the subdivision part of the park "all paved roads" are for the purpose of getting into or out of the subdivision, or to some one's home within the park. They are not for the purpose of a playground for the before mentioned vehicles. There have been many near accidents between these vehicles and autos. In many cases the before mentioned vehicles are not licensed to operate on public or private roads. Sooner or later there will be a serious accident and one or more of your children will be hurt or killed. If your children must ride the vehicles, they may do so on the back country dirt roads where there is practically no car traffic. Be sure the vehicles are equipped with mufflers. Other portions of the subdivision that are prohibited to any vehicles are the meadows, the picnic grounds, camp grounds and other peoples private property.

Rules of the Park pertaining to motor bikes, two, three and four wheelers, skate boards, scooters and dogs:

- No. 1. Do not ride on private property.
- No. 2. Do not use the paved roads as a play area.
- No. 3. Do not race on the paved roads; observe the speed limit.
- No. 4. When on the paved roads observe the proper courtesies of the road
- No. 5. Stay out of the meadows, and off private property
- No. 6. All off road vehicles must have the appropriate license or permit.
- No. 7. Dogs must be kept under control at all times, preferably on a leash, and must be kept away from the lake area.

These rules apply to you as a property owner and to your guests or renters. Please apprise them of their responsibility. It is up to you to police your children.
