He was appointed by former governor [Arnold Schwarzenegger](#) on March 13, 2006 to succeed William Polley.<sup>[1][2][3]</sup> He was re-elected in 2014 for a term that expires in January of 2021.<sup>[4][5]</sup>

Boscoe ran for re-election to the [Tuolumne County Superior Court](#). As an unopposed incumbent, he was automatically re-elected without appearing on the ballot.<sup>[4]</sup>
