

Attending the trial as scheduled on July 15, 2016, will be a hardship for me. I was recently hospitalized for Guillain-Barre syndrome from June 7th through June 15th, and then resided at a rehabilitation facility from June 15th through July 2. I was released from the rehabilitation facility in order to continue with rehab at home. Guillain-Barre syndrome is a disorder in which your immune system attacks your nerves, leading to muscle weakness and/or paralysis. I suffered acute paralysis from this disorder which led to my emergent hospitalization. To date, the paralysis has upgraded to severe weakness and I continue to have limited mobility, which makes traveling a hardship.

I am also asking for a postponement of the trial due to receipt of correspondence from the State of California Public Utilities Commission (attached as Exhibit "A" to my Request for Judicial Notice served and filed herewith) which I received on July 5, 2016.
